Students had made 'Mohabbat ni Roti' and brought it to school, which was served to them through salvaat na thaal and was also shared across staff and other faculty members.



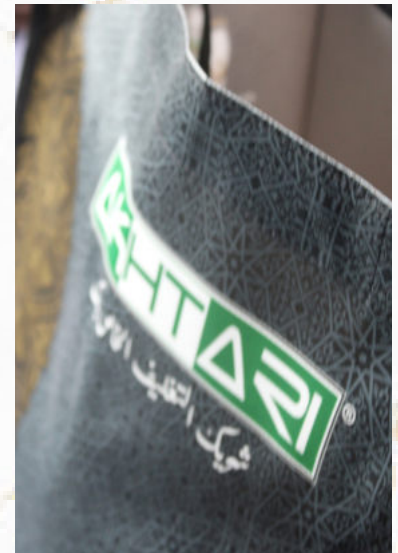

It was in an attempt to provide on-site and active learning. The students learnt about manufacturers and converters of printed flexible packaging materials for the food and tea industry.

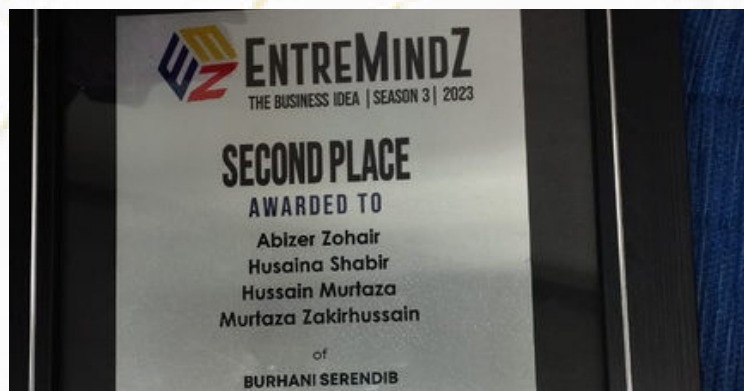


SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENTS

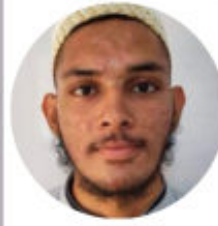

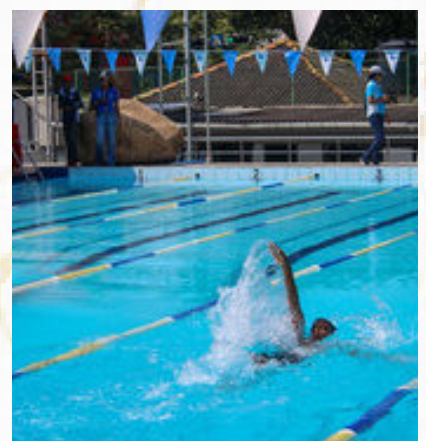
INTER-HOUSE SWIMMING MEET

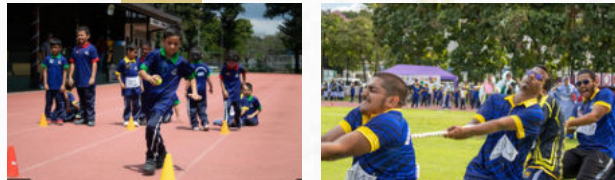
In a heart-stopping moment, Imadi House emerged as the triumphant force, with Najmi House securing a commendable second position in a closely contested showdown.

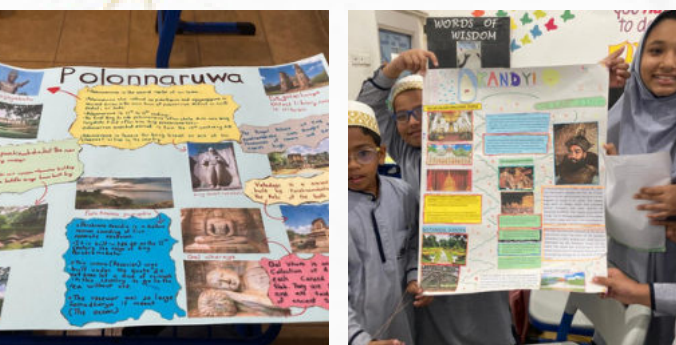
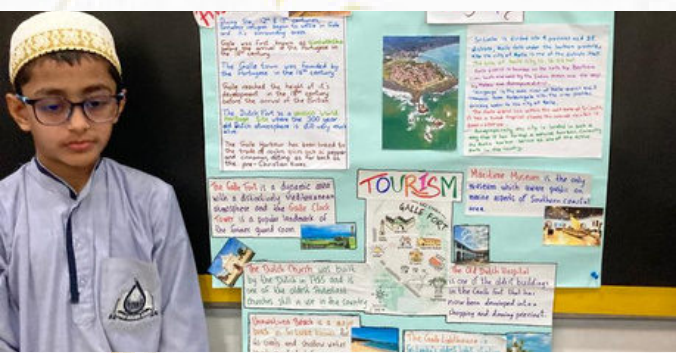
UNLOCKING MATH MAGIC:

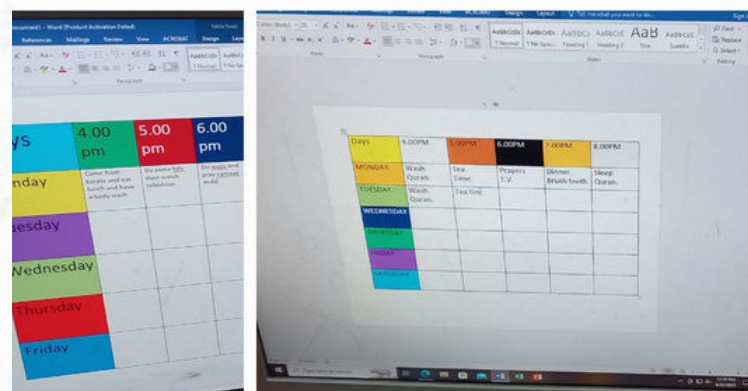
LIFE SKILLS

Engaging in classroom activities transforms learning into an exhilarating journey, let us explore a few captivating class endeavours :

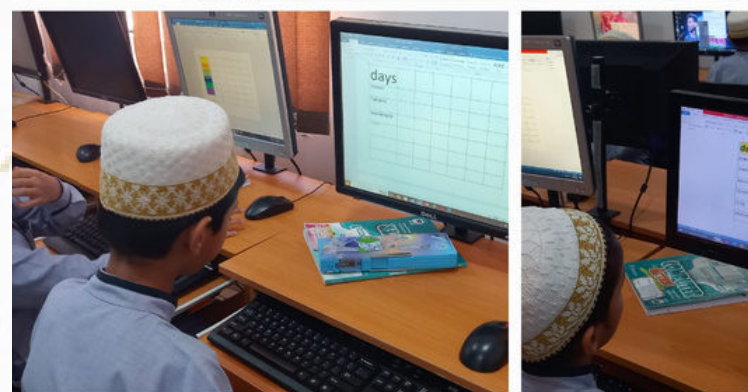
Our young learners of **Primary 1** through a focused session on packing their bags, have successfully embraced **independence and organization.**

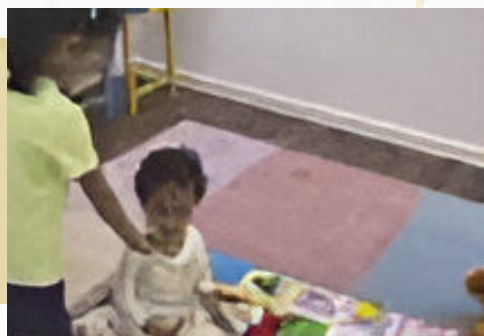
KALAMRO THAAL

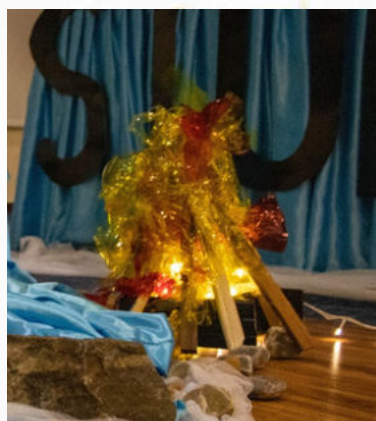

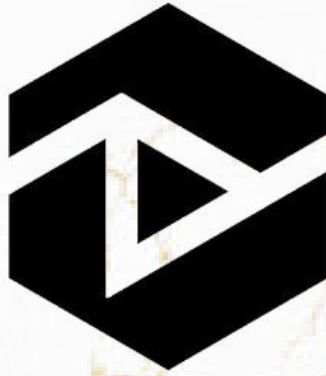
